# THE JUMPING INTERNATIONAL DE DINARD TAKES PLACE FROM 24 TO 27 JULY

A key event on the equestrian calendar, the Jumping International de Dinard, draped in its signature pink, returns from 24 to 27 July 2025 for its 113th edition. The eyes of the equestrian world will turn to Brittany, where one of the most prestigious competitions of the international season will unfold. In 2024, the event featured four categories (CSI5\*, CSI3\*, CSI1\*, and CSI YH for 7-year-old horses), bringing together 150 riders, 380 horses, and 20 nations on the grass arena of the Stade Équestre du Val Porée. ### 2025, A SPECIAL YEAR FOR THE JUMPING INTERNATIONAL DE DINARD

Organised since 2013 by the Mars family, the Dinard competition earned its 5-star status in 2015, a symbol of excellence. For the Jumping International de Dinard, 2025 marks ten years at the sport's highest level—a decade of thrilling memories and unforgettable victories, starting with that of Ireland's Bertram Allen who, in 2015, on his 20th birthday, won the Rolex Grand Prix Ville de Dinard with the brilliant Molly Malone V.

You only have to look at the of list winners in subsequent years to realise that Dinard is indeed a meeting place for the best. IThe list of winners that followed speaks for itself: Germany's Christian Ahlmann (2016), France's Nicolas Delmotte (2017), Alexis Deroubaix (2019), and Kévin Staut (2024), USA's McLain Ward (2018), and Austria's Max Kühner (2023). But only one rider has achieved the feat twice: Switzerland's Martin Fuchs

With its iconic venue and unique ambiance, the event thrills equestrian fans year after year. Since its first edition in 1912, the Jumping International de Dinard has stood the test of time, maintaining its prestige and ranking among the oldest and most esteemed competitions in the world.

"This competition carries a strong sense of history, which gives it another dimension. It truly embodies the essence of our sport," said French rider Kévin Staut, after his 2024 Rolex Grand Prix Ville de Dinard victory. "Dinard is legendary. It's undoubtedly one of the most beautiful grass arenas in Europe. This arena has seen some of the greatest champions compete," added his compatriot Julien Épaillard, runner-up in the 2023 Grand Prix.

A magical experience for both elite and amateur riders, the Jumping International de Dinard continues to make dreams come true. From 24 to 27 July 2025, its 113th edition promises to be truly unforgettable!
