SUEDEN OPENS JUMPING INTERNATIONAL DE DINARD

Thursday, July 30, 2026

Swedish rider Henrik von Eckermann, partnered with Glamour Girl, claimed victory late this afternoon in the Prix Les Estivales de l'Équitation, the feature class of Thursday, 30 July, and the opening highlight of the CSI5* at the Jumping International de Dinard. With an exceptionally strong field assembled this week, the next three days of competition promise world-class sport and spectacular competition. The week will culminate on Sunday afternoon with the Rolex Grand Prix de la Ville de Dinard, the show's marquee event.



The suspense lasted right to the very end in the opening CSI5* class, the Prix Les Estivales de l'Équitation, a 1.45m Two-Phase Speed competition. Designed by French course designer Jean-François Morand, the track challenged a field of 72 horse-and-rider combinations, with 24 producing faultless rounds. Starting 48th, Luxembourg's Victor Bettendorf and Extasia Bella By Classic Z held the lead for much of the class with a time of 33.28 seconds. Their hopes of victory remained alive until the penultimate combination entered the arena, when Tokyo 2020 Olympic team champion and reigning individual World Champion Henrik von Eckermann, aboard his talented mare Glamour Girl, stopped the clock in a winning 32.63 seconds. Belgium's Gudrun Patteet and Sea Coast Chica V.V.Z. completed the podium in third place with a time of 34.24 seconds.

"Dinard has always been a very successful show for us. Glamour Girl wins a class here every year, so she must really enjoy this arena! Starting near the end of today's class was definitely an advantage, and she made the most of it. Even at 15 years old, she goes into the ring with the enthusiasm of a five-year-old. With this victory, she has now recorded 52 career wins, which is simply incredible. Having her owner here this week makes the moment even more special. I'm absolutely delighted. Tomorrow, she'll compete in the 1.45m class. She's naturally very quick, which will allow me to save Qasirah for the weekend's major classes."

CSI3*, 100% FRENCH SUCCESS IN THE PRIX DES EMPLOYÉS MUNICIPAUX DE DINARD

The Val Porée venue woke up this morning to the CSI3* riders and the Prix des Employés Municipaux de la Ville de Dinard. It was a perfect start to the day, with a 100% French podium led by Cédric Angot and Gandor du Fief, who stopped the clock at 61.61 seconds. He was followed by François-Xavier Boudant with Quercus van den Oude Eik in 64.51 seconds, and Mégane Moissonnier aboard Kandoo Z in 65.05 seconds.
