

JUMPING INTERNATIONAL

A firm favourite with equestrian sports fans, **the Jumping International de Dinard** is an international jumping competition graded 5*, the highest level of difficulty in this type of competition. For four days, the Val Porée site will be beating to the rhythm of a high-flying event, attracting more and more spectators every year.

The 2023 event drew almost **50,000 spectators** despite the capricious weather, and 2024 is already shaping up to be a great event, with some great sporting moments in store and the Paris Olympics in sight.

Once again, the **Jumping International de Dinard** will bring together an exceptional line-up of riders, with an exciting programme. **850,000€** in total prize money, some thirty nations expected to take part, representing 170 riders and 350 horses who will compete with fervour in around twenty events. Divided into 4 levels of competition (CSI 5*, CSI 3*, CSI 1* and CSI YH for young horses aged 7), they will take place on the sand track and grass course at Val Porée, considered to be one of the world's most elegant venues.

A HISTORIC SUCCESS FOR AN EXTRAORDINARY EVENT

We don't yet have the final entries, but for several months we've been receiving messages from the world's best riders assuring us of their presence.

This support from the riders and the public is a real source of motivation for our teams to offer an incredible weekend on our magnificent grounds.

Since its first edition in 1912, the Jumping International de Dinard has gone from strength to strength, attracting the best international riders and becoming the oldest of the world's major competitions.

It's an enchanted interlude, accessible to all and entirely free of charge, showcasing sport in its purest form and delighting novices and connoisseurs alike. Set in a natural arena right in the heart of the city and just a stone's throw from the beach, it's a chance for families and friends to enjoy a thrilling and unforgettable spectacle.

For this year's event, we're continuing to aim for a minimum level of waste and carbon footprint: we're doing away with plastic bottles in favour of water fountains for the teams, and the catering outlets will be offering only recyclable packaging - aluminium, bamboo, cardboard - for the general public. The choice of local suppliers has also been given priority.



HIGHLIGHTS



THURSDAY JULY 18TH

Riders and horses will have the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the terrain and the first courses designed by Jean-François Morand (FRA), the ringmaster, with a CSI5* event, at the end of the day (4.30pm).

FRIDAY JULY 19TH

We will see a series of events with higher obstacles: 1.45m for a CSI5* (2.15pm) and 1.55m for the CSI5* (5pm). And the pressure on competitors will only intensify over the weekend.

SATURDAY JULY 20TH

Tradition dictates that the CSI3* **Derby** (4:45pm) will be the highlight of the day. And the public are never mistaken, for it's in front of the packed stands that the scenario for this spectacular event unfolds. For almost 3 minutes, the twenty or so couples taking part will set off on a 1,100m course with a historic layout, comprising traditional obstacles (doubles, oxers, verticals, etc.) and natural obstacles (barriers, mounds, Breton embankments, fords, etc.) 1.45m high. Thrills and spills in store!

SUNDAY JULY 21ST

The best couples from the CSI5*, CSI3* and CSI1* classes will compete in the Grands Prix. And since it's tradition to save the best for last, the world's elite in the CSI5* will take to the track at 2.45pm to compete in the 500,000 euro **Rolex Grand Prix Ville de Dinard**. And there's no shortage of talent expected for this masterful final!



THE JEWEL OF THE COTE D'EMERAUDE

Authenticity and life style lovers, there is no better place in Brittany than the Cote d'Emeraude; a colourful setting with wild sceneries, multiple smells and flavours that expose, among its precious patrimony, a jewel: Dinard.

This fishing village from the 19th century is famous for being one of the most beautiful sea resorts in Europe. Gifted with an exceptional architectural patrimony, the City of Dinard ows its reputation to its numerous villas from the Belle Epoque period, concentrated on the sea side, opposite the Jersey island. Its beaches make people dream. Located a stone throw away from the Val Porée stadium, the Prieuré beach is the first stop for pleasure sailors who cross the Rance dam, but the beach from the Ecluse remains the vacationers' favorite.

Dinard is also a sportive city: from equestrian sport with its mythical International Jumping, but also golf, cycling, and nautical sports of course. For the Paddle and Kayak lovers, the Cote d'Emeraude, which spreads from Cap Fréhel to Cancale, delivers its secrets by the Prieuré beach. Three hours of aquatic sport before crossing the 23 hectares of the Port Breton and his manor, its rose gardens, its wild life and the unconditionnal desire to spend a few days in Ile et Vilaine arises.

The focal point of this edition, offering one of the season's most coveted prizes, will be the Rolex Grand Prix of Dinard on Sunday 30 July.
